- 1. Press the **Alt** key to see the menu bar below, and select **Tools**, or click the Tools icon browser window.
- From the Tools drop down menu, select Compatibility View settings.
- In the Add this website: box type mlsstratus.com. Click Add, then click Close.
- Click on Tools, as in Step 1, and use the drop down menu to select **Internet options**.
- Select the Security tab. Select Trusted sites and click the Sites button.
- 6. In the Trusted sites window, uncheck the box for Require server verification (https) for all sites in this zone. Enter the following into the Add this website to the zone: box, one at a time, clicking the Add button after each entry.

You do not need to enter the (*.) before the website address.

It will be added automatically.)

When finished, click Close.

- 7. Next, select the **Privacy** tab. Click the **Settings** button next to **Turn on Pop-up Blocker**. If there is no check in the box next to Turn on Pop-up Blocker, skip this step and go to Step 9.
- Enter the following information in the Address of website to allow: box, one at a time, clicking the Add button after each entry.

When finished, click Close.

- In the Advanced tab, scroll down to Enable third-party browser extensions*, and uncheck the box. Click Apply, then click OK.
- Close Internet Explorer and reopen it. You are ready to use Stratus!

Safari

- Click the drop down arrow on the "Display a menu of general Safari settings" button on the top right corner of your browser window.
- If there is a check next to Block Pop-Up Windows, uncheck it.

Chrome

- In the Content settings window scroll down to the Pop-ups section and click the Manage exceptions... button.
- 6. Enter the following websites in the **Pop-up exceptions** window box, one at a time, clicking the **Allow** button after each entry.

Firefox

- In the Options window, select the Applications tab. Scroll down to Portable Document Format (PDF), and use the down arrow to open the drop down menu. Select, Use Adobe Acrobat (in Firefox).

- 4. Next, select **Content**, and click the **Exceptions** button.
- Enter the following in the Allowed Sites -Pop-ups window under Address of website: clicking Allow after each entry.
